device or telephone

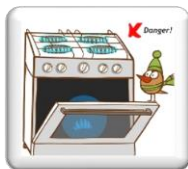


leave the building

number, or **9-1-1**

## DO NOT...



use a gas stove or range  
to heat your home



play around household  
appliances

## ANOTHER IMPORTANT NOTE!!!

Natural gas has no color, no taste, and no smell, but gas smells of rotten eggs - everyone knows this! In fact, this happens because after extraction, a special substance is added to it - an odorant, the smell of which resembles that of rotten eggs. The odorant is necessary in order to warn people of a leak - after all, gas is explosive and poisonous to humans.

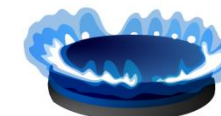
