REMEMBER...

Young children should never be left alone or left without proper supervision, but if you are left home alone, here are 8 rules to follow that will help keep you safe.

#1

Do not have friends over without an adult in the house to supervise.

#2

Keep doors and windows closed and locked.

#3

Do not open the door for anyone, even if you know the person.

#4

Do not answer the phone, and never tell anyone you're home alone.

#5

Make sure you have a trusted neighbor you can go to if you need help.

#6

Never use the oven, range top, or other potentially dangerous items.

#7

Do not horseplay.

#8

If there is an emergency, do not hesitate to call **9-1-1**.
