

POISON & MEDICATION SAFETY

When it comes to chemicals and medications, **ALWAYS**...

STOP!

Ask First

NEVER touch, use or consume chemicals or medications without a parent's approval and supervision.

Immediately tell an adult or call **9-1-1** if someone, including you, has been exposed to a poisonous substance, such as a household cleanser, the wrong medication, or too much medication.

S.A.I.L.

- Solids:
- poison ivy, poison oak, poison berries, some types of medications, and etc.



- Aerosols: spray paint, bug spray, window cleaner, and etc.
- **Invisibles:** carbon monoxide, smoke from a car exhaust, cigarette smoke, and etc.

- **Liquids:** bleach, household cleansers, some types of medications, and etc.
